



# Reynella Football Club Junior League for 2018

To all parents and players,

Welcome to the 2018 season. The Junior league is an important league to The Reynella Football Club as this program, is the central building block to sustained success for our club for many years to come. The Club's commitment to junior football is an absolute key reason we have won many premierships.

Thank you for choosing the Reynella Football Club to start or continue your child's football program. The below information are guidelines on what you need to know to register your child with the Reynella Football Club.

## Reynella Football Club Information

### PLAYER UNIFORM

It is a SFL requirement that all players wear endorsed shorts and socks. These can be purchased within the Club. Players will also be required to wear a mouth guard for all games. Game day Guernsey will be provided by the Club and players are required to return the Guernsey to their team mangers after each Game.

Compulsory uniform required are:

- Black SFL AFL football shorts (Can be purchased through the Club)
- Black SFL football socks (Can be purchased through the Club)
- Mouth Guard  
RFC has organised a dentist to be at the club on the 13th of March from 6pm. For anyone who wants to order a proper moulded mouth guard, please check on face book to book in a time.  
\$70 for a moulded mouth guard with a 1 or 2 colour combination.  
\$75 for a moulded month guard with a 3 colour combination.

### Player Game day uniform

Junior players are required to represent the Reynella Football Club in a professional manner when going to and from all Games. All players are required to wear the following to and from all games and to any club presentations that may be held.

- Black dress slacks (**NO SHORTS ARE TO BE WORN TO GAMES OR PRESENTATIONS**)
- Black dress shoes
- Black socks
- Official Reynella Polo Top
- Reynella Jacket / Jumper (optional)

## **VOLUNTEERS & EXPECTATIONS**

### **Volunteers**

The Reynella Football Club is successful due to the dedication of their Volunteers. Although the club has assigned coaches for Under 13 and under 15 Saturday squads, we still require coaches to be appointed for the Sunday squads. Depending on the number of returning players and new players, we may need 2 additional coaches for the under 15 squad and 1 additional coach for Under 13. These coaches will assist the Under 13 and Under 15 head coaches. If you are interested in coaching but don't have coaching accreditation the Reynella Football Club will assist with obtaining the required training. All Volunteers MUST also have a police clearance. These Police clearance will be paid for by the SFL.

Permanent roles that needs to be filled for each teams are:

- Assistant Coach
- Team Manager
- Team Runner
- 2 x Team Trainer / First aid (must hold current first aid certificate)

Game day Volunteering.

As the squad may change weekly due to the selection process, the team manager will ask people to help out on game day jobs. These jobs may include:

- BBQ Duties
- Canteen Duties
- Time Keeper (must be 12 years or older)
- Goal umpire (must be 12 years or older)
- Water boy (must be 12 years or older)
- Boundary Umpire (must be 12 years or older)
- Washing of Guernsey's

### **RFC Expectations**

During the season, **all parents are expected to volunteer their time** to help out with the jobs listed above. The Reynella Football Club is successful due to its volunteers, please make the effort to help.

All parents, volunteers, spectators and family friends are expected to read and make yourselves familiar with the **"Reynella Football Club Parent/Guardian/Spectator Code of Conduct"**. Please make sure that you abide by these rules at all times. The Reynella Football Club will not tolerate any one who breaches the code of conduct.

### **TRAINING AND PRESENTATIONS**

Training will be organised by the head coach of each age group and will train together as one squad. There will be two training sessions each week. Team selections will be allocated by the Thursday before the weekend Game. If you have any concerns on the ability of your child, please make the coaches aware. If you have any issues with the coach or any officials, **please do not voice them with other parents** and come and see the coach or the team manager.

Presentations for the Saturday and Sunday sides will be held at the club. Presentations for Saturday players will be on Saturday night starting at 6pm during a home game and starting 6:30pm during an away game. Presentations for Sunday players will be late in the afternoon on Sunday starting at 4pm during a home game and starting at 4:30pm during an away game.

**It is expected that all players return to the club rooms for team presentations.** Information and updates about the season will be provided during the presentations so, it is very important that all parents and players attend.




Saturday Presentations will be with the senior presentations. Hot food will be available for purchase and the bar will be open. Please note that all players and parents are expected to clean your own plates and cutlery.

### **REYNELLA WINEFLIES JUNIOR TEAM APP**

The Reynella Junior team managers and officials will be communicating with all players and parents throughout the year through the Team App application. The Reynella Team App can be downloaded on your smart device through the Apple App Store or the Google Play store.



You can sign up on a PC, smartphone or tablet.

- On your smartphone or tablet, please download the “team app” application  in the apple app store  or google play store 
- Sign up and fill in all your details. Please make sure you use an email that you use every day.
- Once you have registered and downloaded the app, you need sign into your team app account with your email address
- Search for “Reynella Wineflies Juniors”
- Select “Reynella Wineflies Juniors” and select become a member of this team.
- Select the age group your child is in “2018 Under 13 etc.”.
- Select continue and type in the player’s name or your relationship with the player under “Access Request Message”
- Select “send”

## **Reynella Sports & Social Club (RSSC)**

The Reynella Sports and Social Club (RSSC) plays a big part to support The Reynella Football Club (RFC). ## **PAYMENT PLANS**

An additional \$5 administration fee will be applied. Payments will be divided into 3 instalments and deducted from a nominated credit card for fortnight.

## SOUTHERN FOOTBALL LEAGUE (SFL) ONLINE REGISTRATION
