Registration Information

SOUTHERN FOOTBALL LEAGUE (SFL) ONLINE REGISTRATION

In addition to registering with the Club, please remember that **all players** are required to register with the SFL via the Sporting Pulse website. **If you do not register with the SFL, you will not be allowed to play as you will not be insured.**

For returning players, you should have received an email prompting you to reregister your child. Please advise RFC if you did not get an email. The most often cited reason for not receiving the email is that your details on Sporting Pulse are not up to date. All players need to go to the following site for SFL registrations.

Once you are on the site, please select Reynella FC and then follow the instructions thereafter. Please **do not** make or send payments of membership fees through the SFL web site. All payments must go through the Reynella Minis accounts.

NEW PLAYERS

New players are required to complete the online registration and all forms in red are to be returned to the Club.

A copy of the player's birth certificate needs to be provided to the Club. This will allow Club officials to witness proof of age requirements for the SFL. If you don't have a copy of the birth certificate, you will be required to fill in a statutory declaration form and have it signed by a Justice of Peace Representative. During registration night, we will have a JP available to assist.

REYNELLA SPORTS AND SOCIAL CLUB (RSSC)

The Reynella Sports and Social Club (RSSC) plays a big part to support The Reynella Football Club (RFC). The Football club relies on the RSSC to maintain the oval, pay all the utilities (water, electricity and gas), maintenance of the club rooms and build facilities. If the RFC did not have the backing of the RSSC, the Reynella Football club will be liable for all these expenses. This is the reason why we need to support the RSSC as much as possible. Every dollar you spend behind the bar goes towards the RSSC. We also invite all families to become a member of the RSSC for a small fee.

This membership will provide you the following

- \$1 off all drinks during happy hour (every Friday night 6pm to 7pm)

PLAYER GEAR AND OTHER MERCHANDISE

It is a SFL requirement that all players wear endorsed shorts and socks. Players will also be required to wear a mouth guard for all games. Game day Guernsey will be provided by the Club and players are required to return the Guernsey to their team mangers after each Game.

Compulsory uniform required are:

- Black SFL AFL football shorts (available at the Club)
- Black SFL football socks (available at the Club)
- Mouth Guard (please organise through your own dentist)

Other merchandise will be available from the club and will be available on the registration night. Items will include club polo shirts, jackets, bags, hats and beanies. We encourage all of our players to wear the Clubs Polo tops on match day before and after the game. VOLUNTEERS

We still require additional coaches, team managers and other volunteers for the 2019 season. Although most of our coaches from 2018 are returning please let me know if you can assist at the U8, U10 and U12 levels.

If you are interested in coaching but don't have coaching accreditation the Reynella Football Club will assist with obtaining the required training.

If you are interested in assisting in other roles there will be a volunteer sheet to sign up for at the club on registration night. All volunteers will need to have police checks completed.

Please keep a look out for further announcements about the Minis this year on the Club's website or Facebook page.

RFC EXPECTATIONS

During the season, **all parents are expected to volunteer their time** to help out with Game day BBQ, oval set up, Game day Oranges for the kids, washing Guernsey's, time keeper, goal umpire, and Friday night kitchen duties. A roster will be provided by your team manager on when you are required to volunteer your time. If you cannot fulfil your rostered job/s, please let your team manager know well in advance. **If you are rostered and fail to turn up, your child will be benched and will not participate with the game you are rostered on.** The Reynella Football Club is successful due to its volunteers, please make the effort to help.

All parents, volunteers, spectators and family friends are expected to read and make yourselves familiar with the **"Reynella Football Club Parent/Guardian/Spectator Code of Conduct"**. Please make sure that you abide by these rules at all times. The Reynella Football Club will not tolerate any one who breaches the code of conduct.

TEAMS

- **Under 8 teams** – Players who are or will be turning 7 or 8 in 2019 (Born in 2011 and 2012)
- **Under 10 teams** – Players who are or will be turning 9 or 10 in 2019 (Born in 2009 and 2010)
- **Under 12 teams** – Players who are or will be turning 11 or 12 in 2019 (Born in 2007 and 2008)

TRAINING/PRESENTATIONS/GAME DAY TIMES

All age groups in the Minis's competition will train on Friday nights followed by team presentations from 6pm onwards. Training will start in March at an Oval yet to be determined due to the Reynella Oval being used for Cricket. During the Footy season, training will be held at the Reynella Oval but sometimes training may be held at another site. We will only organise training at another site if the condition of the Oval during the winter season is bad or, if there is a Friday night game on. If this does happen, all players and parents will be notified.

The Reynella Sports and Social Club will open the upstairs Bar for drinks from 5:30pm during Friday night training. The Reynella Football Club will also open the kitchen for hot food to be purchased from 6pm onwards.

It is expected that all players return to the club rooms after training for team presentations. Information and updates about the season will be provided during the presentations so, it is very important that all parents and players attend. Presentations will go for 30 to 45 minutes and will start from under 8's and finish with under 12's.

If you cannot attend any presentations or games, it is expected you let your team manager know and why you cannot attend.

Preseason training will start the following times at Wirreanda High School. Training will be held at Wirreanda until the Cricket season finishes.

- Games on Sunday morning starting at 11am sharp. All players must be at the nominated oval at 10:20am

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Speed limit around the Reynella Football Club is 10km. Please stick to the speed limit when you are parking your car.

It is expected that all players are accompanied by a Parent/Guardian at all times during training and game day. Dropping off players to training and Game day where a parent/guardian is not present is **not acceptable**.

The Reynella Football Club is not a child care drop off centre.

The Reynella Football Club expects all Parents/Guardians to be present with your child during all training times and game day matches.

The Reynella Football Club are aware that some of the registered player's parents are separated. The RFC request all serious matters to be notified to the club, by letter, if the registered player is involved with any of the following;

- Custody of child agreement
- Any Restraining orders for the child and for any participating parents.

Your information will be confidential. Only the Coach, Team Manager and RFC officials will have access to the information you have provided. RFC has an authorised Child Protection officer and will be able to assist you if needed.

REYNELLA WINEFLIES MINI'S TEAM APP

The Reynella Mini's team managers and officials will be communicating with all players and parents throughout the year through the Team App application. The Reynella Team App can be downloaded on your smart device through the Apple App Store or the Google Play store.



You can sign up on a PC, smartphone or tablet.

- On a PC, please go to <https://www.teamapp.com/> and sign up for the application.
- On your smartphone or tablet, please download the “team app” application  in the apple app store  or google play store 
- Sign up and fill in all your details. Please make sure you use an email that you use every day.
- Once you have registered and downloaded the app, you need sign into your team app account with your email address
- Search for “Reynella Wineflies Minis”
- Select “Reynella Wineflies Minis” and select become a member of this team.
- Select “Family members” and the age group your child is in “2018 Under 8 etc.”.
- Select continue and type in the player's name or your relationship with the player under “Access Request Message”
- Select “send”

Once you are registered on the app, you will be automatically assigned to your team once teams have been announced.

PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES

Player registration fees for Minis are \$165 (inc GST) per player

PAYMENT PLANS

RFC understands that registration fees are sometimes hard for some families to come up with upfront. In 2019, we will be organising a payment plan for those families who choose to pay the fees off.

Payments will be divided into 2 instalments and deducted from a nominated credit card every fortnight.

An additional \$5 charge will be added to the fees for administration to organise part payment.
