CLUB HISTORY

- Est 1896 on the 18th of April. One of the oldest Football Clubs in Australia
- 1913 joined Mid Southern Competition
- 1928 RFC merged with Morphett Vale to play in the SFL
- 1930 Reynella FC became their own club and wore Black & Red to play in the Glenelg Comp.
- 1947 returned to the SFL Comp changing colours to Brown & Gold
- 1968 Reynella FC changed to Black & White and has not turned back.
- 1969 RFC Won our first A-Grade Premiership against Christies Beach by 16 points 11.3 (69) to 7.11 (53)
- From 1970 to 1978, RFC played in seven grand finals, winning 2 Premierships in 1975 against McLaren Flat and 1977 against Port Noarlunga
- Played in the 1985 & 1998 Grand final but did not win the chocolates
- 2010 the premiership draught was broken after 33 years. Won the Grand Final against Brighton by 30 points 13.11(89 to 9.5 (59)
- 2013 Michael Doughty returned to the Club leading the team to win another Grand Final against Morphett Vale 12.11 (83 to 8.10 (58)
- 2015 Season - Most successful year - Won 4 premierships in 4 grades
- A Grade / B Grade / U16 Saturday Side / U16 Sunday Side
- Successful Junior program in the next 5 years
- 2016 - U16 Saturday Side won the Premiership & U14 Saturday Side made it into the Grand Final
- 2017 & 2018 U13 won the Premiership
- 2017 - U17.5 won the Premiership & U15 Saturday Side made it into the Grand Final
- Successful 2021 Season
- U13, U15 & U17.5 Saturday Side won the Premiership
- U14 SANFL Sunday Side won the Premiership
- U14 Girls and A-Grade made the Grand Final
- A & B-Grade Men played in the Finals Series

- In 2022, we had 11 teams play in a premiership season. 4 senior teams and 7 junior teams. We had 6 teams finishing as 2022 Minor premiers finishing on top of the ladder, A-Grade Men's, A-Grade Women's, B-Grade Men's, U15 SFL Boys, U14 SFL Girls & U14 SANFL Boys and 10 teams played in the final series. 6 teams play in a Grand Final game and our U14 Girls, U14 Boys SANFL and A-Grade Men's won the Flag and became 2022 Premiers.

- In 2023, out of the 25 teams, we had 13 teams play for premiership points. 4 Teams finished as Minor Premiers; U14 Girls, U13 Boys, U15 Sunday Boys, C-Grade Men's. 10 Teams played in the final's series; Girls team - U14, A-Grade, Boys team – U13, U15 Sat & Sun, U17.5 SANFL & SFL, A,B & C Grade Men's. 3 teams played in the Preliminary Finals, U17.5 SANFL Boys, A & B Grade Men's and 6 Teams Played in the Grand Final Girls team - U14, A-Grade, Boys team –U13, U15 Sat & Sun, C-Grade Men's
In 2024 we nearly doubled our premiership wins from last year with 5 Premierships. A Massive congratulations to our U14 SFL Girls, U13 Boys, U15 Sunday Boys and our C-Grade Men's for becoming 2023 premiers. A Massive congratulations to our A-Grade Women's for winning our first Premiership for the SFL women's league for Reynella. In 2023, we have now rewritten the history book that Reynella has won our first A-Grade SFL Women's Premiership in 2023.

- Create a new Account and follow all the prompts.
- If you are eligible for the \$100 government sport voucher, make sure you select Government Voucher and enter in your Medicare number at the payment screen at the end. This will discount your fees by \$100
 - Please do not forget to add the position number of your child at the end of your Medicare number on the voucher code.
 - Example
 - Medicare number is **2345 2345 2345**
 - Your child is on position **4** on your Medicare card.
 - You need to enter **2345 2345 2345 4** on the voucher code.
- PLEASE PAY FEES WHEN YOU REGISTER ONLINE. NO PAYMENT IS MADE TO THE CLUB.

New players for Reynella FC that are transferring for another SFL club must complete the following:

- Fill in the SA Community Football League Inc. Player Registration & Transfer Form (attached)
- Need to supply a copy of birth certificate. (photocopy only – NO photos)
- **Once this is completed, then you will be able to follow the above steps on new players registrations. You cannot play if you do not fill in the forms and hand them in.**
- **Please do not leave this to the last minute as it may takes 2 weeks for the Southern Football League to approve new players and transfers.**

TRAINING/PRESENTATIONS/GAME DAY TIMES

All age groups in the Minis competition will train on Friday nights followed by team presentations from 5.45pm onwards. Training at Reynella Oval is yet to be determined due to the Reynella Oval being used for Cricket. During the cricket season, training will be held at the Wirreanda High School.

The Reynella Sports and Social Club will open the upstairs Bar for drinks from 5:30pm during Friday night training. The Reynella Football Club will also open the kitchen for hot food to be purchased from 6pm onwards.

It is expected that all players return to the club rooms after training for team presentations. Information and updates about the season will be provided during the presentations so, it is very important that all parents and players attend. Presentations will be held at the end of each training session in the club.

If you cannot attend any presentations or games, it is expected you let your team manager know.

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Speed limit around the Reynella Football Club is 10km. Please stick to the speed limit when you are parking your car.

It is expected that all players are accompanied by a Parent/Guardian at all times during training and game day. Dropping off players to training and game day where a parent/guardian is not present is **not acceptable**.

The Reynella Football Club expects all Parents/Guardians to be present with your child during all training times and game day matches.

The Reynella Football Club are aware that some of the registered player's parents are separated. The RFC request all serious matters to be notified to the club, by letter, if the registered player is involved with any of the following;

- Custody of child agreement
- Any Restraining orders for the child and for any participating parents.

Your information will be confidential. Only the Coach, Team Manager and RFC officials will have access to the information you have provided. RFC has an authorised Child Protection officer and will be able to assist you if needed.

PLAYER GEAR AND OTHER MERCHANDISE

It is an SFL requirement that all players wear endorsed shorts and socks. Players will also be required to wear a mouth guard for all games. Game day guernsey will be provided by the Club and players are required to return the guernsey to their team managers after each game.

Compulsory uniform required are:

- Black SFL AFL football shorts (available at the Club)
- Black SFL football socks (available at the Club)
- Mouth Guard (please organise through your own dentist)

Other merchandise will be available throughout the season. Items will include club polo shirts, jackets, bags, hats and beanies. We encourage all of our players to wear the Clubs Polo tops on match day before and after the game. Please go to <http://www.reynellaafc.com.au/store>

VOLUNTEERS

We still require additional coaches, team managers and other volunteers for the 2024 season.

All volunteers will need to have police checks completed.

If you cannot fulfil your rostered job/s, please let your team manager know well in advance. **If you are rostered and fail to turn up, your child will be benched and will not participate with the game you are rostered on.** The Reynella Football Club is successful due to its volunteers, please make the effort to help.

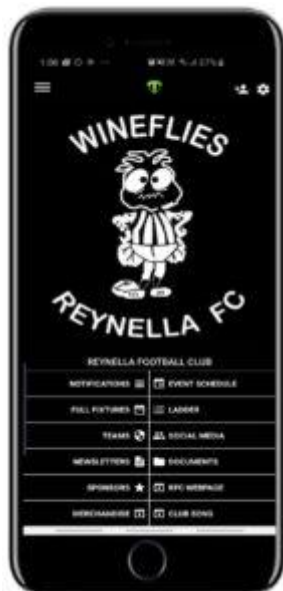
