Game Day Uniform

All players are expected to wear the following uniform to all games and from all games.

- RFC polo top or jumper – Please **DONOT** wear your warm up tops.
- RFC black track pants / Black Jeans / Black Chinos / Black slacks / Black Skirt / Black Leggings
 - If you don't have the RFC black track pants, plain black track pants are acceptable with **NO** stripes or logos.
- Black sneakers or shoes are to be worn with your pants.
- **Strictly NO SHORTS or Demin JEANS**

Compulsory Game gear requirements

- Official Black SFL Shorts (can be purchased through the Club)
- Official SFL/RFC Black football Socks (can be purchased through the Club)
 - **Plain black socks are NOT allowed.**
- Warm up Tops – to be worn during warm up sessions only. **NOT** to be worn to presentations.
- Mouth Guard
- Drink bottle
- Footy Boots
- Guernseys are provided on Game Day & to be returned to team manager after the game.

Presentations

After each round (game) all players are expected to attend game day presentations to present the top 6 SFL best on ground (BOG) for the game played. Presentations are held at the club and Hot meals will be available for sale on Sunday. All grades that play on Sunday will have a time slot for BOG presentations.

Sunday Sides

Sunday presentations start at 5:30pm at the club. All players are expected to be at presentations

All players are expected to wear the following uniform when attending presentations.

- RFC polo top or jumper – Please DONOT wear your warm up tops.

Volunteers & Club Expectations

The Reynella Football Club is not a childcare drop off centre.

The code of conduct's and policies will be provided to you by your team manager. You are required to sign the forms and hand it back to your team manager.

The Reynella Football Club are aware that some of the registered player's parents are separated. The RFC request all serious matters to be notified to the club, by letter, if the registered player is involved with any of the following.

- Custody of child agreement
- Any Restraining orders for the child and for any participating parents.

Your information will be confidential. Only the Coach, Team Manager and RFC officials will have access to the information you have provided. RFC has an authorised Child Protection officer and will be able to assist you if needed.

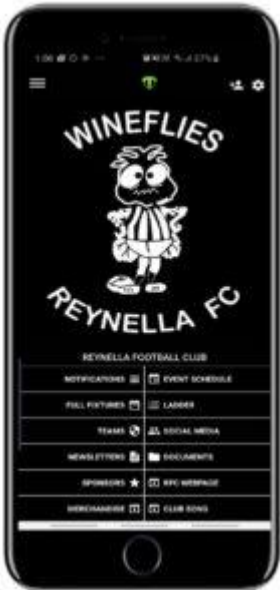
Game Day Volunteering.

Reynella Wineflies Team App

The Reynella Junior team managers and officials will be communicating with all players and parents throughout the year through the Team App application. The Reynella Team App can be downloaded on your smart device through the Apple App Store or the Google Play store.



You can sign up on a PC, smartphone or tablet.

- On a PC, please go to <https://www.teamapp.com/> and sign up for the application.
- On your smartphone or tablet, please download the “team app” application  in the apple app store  or google play store 
- Sign up and fill in all your details. Please make sure you use an email that you use every day.
- Once you have registered and downloaded the app, you need sign into your team app account with your email address
- Search for “Reynella Football Club”
- Select “Reynella Football Club” and select become a member of this team.
- Select “RFC Family & Friends” & the team you are associated with. Eg Under 13 boys
- Select continue and type in the player’s name or your relationship with the player under “Access Request Message”
- Select “send”

Registration Information

PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES

Junior Player registration fees are \$290 (inc GST) per player.

The fees include:

- Compulsory Warm up tops
- Only to be worn during warm-up sessions on Gameday.
- SFL Player affiliation fee
- Reynella Community Centre player levy
- Access to club facilities
- Insurance during game time and training sessions

The Football Club also offers a part payment program through Afterpay. Please note that there is a 7% additional charge if you chose this option.

NEW & RETURNING PLAYERS

Please make sure you have completed the online registration and agree with the following.

- Please go to <http://www.reynellafc.com.au/grades/juniorgirls>
- click on the register here link
- PlayHQ link will appear. Scroll down and click on “get started”
- Create a new Account or enter in your account from last year and follow all the prompts.
- Make sure that you order your warm-up top on the registration
- If you are eligible for the \$100 government sport voucher, at the end of the form where you enter your credit card details, make sure you select “I HAVE A GOVERNMENT VOUCHER” tab and enter in your Medicare number This will discount your fees by \$100
 - Please do not forget to add the position number of your child at the end of your Medicare number on the voucher code.
 - Example
 - Medicare number is **2345 2345 2345**
 - Your child is on position **4** on your Medicare card.
 - You need to enter **2345 2345 2345 4** on the voucher code.
- SA Government Sports Voucher MUST also be filled in and also handed to your team manager.
- PLEASE PAY FEES WHEN YOU REGISTER ONLINE. NO PAYMENT IS MADE TO THE CLUB.

New players for Reynella FC that are transferring for another SFL club must complete the following:

- **Fill in the SA Community Football League Inc. Player Registration & Transfer Form (attached)**
- **Need to supply a copy of birth certificate. (photocopy only – NO photos)**
- **Once this is completed, then you will be able to follow the Above steps on new players registrations.**
